CLIFF-GILA GRANT COUNTY FAIR

Division XI **School Arts and Crafts Exhibits** (Preschool-K), (1-5), (6-8), (9-12), (SpEd)

Exhibits will open for public viewing each morning of the Fair at 8:30 a.m. and will close to the public at 7:00 p.m. Exhibits will be released at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday (closing day of Fair).

All projects must be done by students under supervision of their teacher.

The arts and crafts division is open to all forms of expression and materials so long and the medium is not a hazard to the facility, nor the subject matter offensive to the public.

Each classroom may enter two individual items or one group project.

Art teachers grades 6-12 may enter more items due to the size and nature of their classes, and because they may be the only art teacher for an entire school building.

Group Project means one object made by an entire class or similar individual objects that have been clustered and encircled or attached to something to form an interesting display.

All entries need to be labeled with name of individual or class, grade, teacher, and school.

Entries that meet the requirements will be judged and receive a ribbon. Those projects that do not meet above requirements will be exhibited for display only.

Entries will be judged by grade level. One rosette will be awarded at each grade level.

Judging will be done on originality, neatness, demonstrated use of medium, and attractiveness of display.

Exhibits must be removed at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday (closing day of Fair).

Division X **Science Project Exhibits** (Preschool-K), (1-5), (6-8), (9-12), (SpEd)

Exhibits will open for public viewing each morning of the Fair at 8:30 a.m. and will close to the public at 7:00 p.m. exhibits will be released at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday (closing day of Fair).

All projects must be done by students under supervision of their teacher.

Posters, unattended experiments, displays, models, mobiles, etc. are acceptable, so long as they do not create a hazard to the facility, or to the public, nor the subject matter offensive to the public.

Each classroom may enter two individual items or one group project. Group Project means one object made by entire class or similar individual objects that have been clustered and encircled or attached or something to form an interesting display.

All entries need to be labeled with name of individual or class, grade, teacher, and school. Entries that meet the requirements will be judged and receive a ribbon. Those projects that do not meet above requirements will be exhibited for display only.

Entries will be judged by grade level. One rosette will be awarded at each grade level.

Judging will be done on originality, subject matter, neatness, and attractiveness of display.

Exhibits must be removed at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday (closing day of Fair).
